- 1. ROTA If you are unable to take your place on the rota arrange a swop if you can. If not, do not worry. Others will cover for you on the day as you will for others in your turn.
- 2. WASHING HANDS. It is good practice to wash your hands on the altar after you arrive. There is a bowl and towel provided on both sides of the altar.
- 3. BLESSING OF CHILDREN and NON CATHOLICS. With the host make the sign of the cross over the head of the child or the adult with a simple blessing like "The Blessings of Christ" or "May the Lord who loves you care for you." Or if you forget the words, just make the sign on the cross. There is no need to touch the adult or the child on the head.

4. CLEANING OF THE CHALICE If some of the precious blood remains in the chalice there is no need to consume it if you do not want to. Just put it on the altar. I will either consume it or put it in the tabernacle. When the chalice is empty take it to the side table, pour a little water in the chalice, "slosh" it around then consume the water. Holding the chalice in your hand, move the cloth around the inside of the chalice. Do not move the chalice around the cloth or you might unscrew the chalice. Then leave the chalice on the side table.
